

PLAY VIDEO

Click here to play a video on the display. Enter a URL, or select the video from your device. You can queue multiple videos to play consecutively and save as a playlist to access later.

SHARE SCREEN

If you use an Apple device you, may need to engage Screen Mirroring/Airplay. Long click for split screen

SCREENSHOT

A screenshot of the screen being presented will be saved to your device. You can also select Annotate from the notification to use the annotation tools on your screenshot.

LINK SHARING

Copy and paste a URL to instantly share content with your class.

STOP SHARING

Stop sharing your screen, or your student's screen if they are presenting.

PAUSE SCREEN

Pause what you are sharing to the screen. It will leave a static piece of content, freeing up your device.

MOVIE MODE

Improves the quality of video streaming directly from your device with a two-second delay between your device and the screen, allowing the file to buffer for smooth video play.

WHITEBOARD

Annotate over a virtual whiteboard.
You can also load a background image
to annotate over.



PRIVACY MODE

Turn off the Capture Screenshot functionality.

VOLUME CONTROL

Control the volume of the video you are playing on the display from your app.

SETTINGS

→ STREAM SETTINGS

Adjust the way Vivi streams to your classroom display.

→ ROOM SETTINGS

Activate room features like Open Access to give everyone in the class presentation privileges.

→ PREFERENCES

Adjust the way Vivi works on your computer.

GUEST ACCESS

If you have a guest presenter, create a code for them to access the screen without the need for them to login.

CLOCKS & TIMERS

From the home screen of the Vivi app, educators can now display analog and digital clocks, stopwatches, and timers

GIVE CONTROL TO A STUDENT

See which students are connected to the room and which have requested control. To grant access, simply click the student's name. You can also preview what's on a student's device if they have requested control.

POLLS

Monitor student wellbeing through emoji response polls, with questions such as, "How do you feel today?", and "How do you feel about the lesson?".

ASSESSMENT

Create a multiple choice (numerical or alphabetical), Yes/No. or True/False poll.
